MEDICAL SCHEME ACCREDITATION – 2026 YEAR

1. Your application for accreditation for the 2026 year refers.
2. Your application is successful, your scheme is accredited for the 2026 year, as approved by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 19 August 2025.
3. The accredited schemes are allowed to conduct their marketing from Wednesday, 1 October 2025 to Friday, 28 November 2025.
4. The accreditation of your scheme is subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - a) The accredited scheme must continue to comply with the accreditation criteria provisions in the Main Collective Agreement for the duration of accreditation, being 1 January 2026 to 31 December 2026.
 - b) The accredited medical scheme undertakes to comply with the code of conduct provisions set out in the Main Collective Agreement, during the freedom of association period in 2025 and the duration of accreditation, being 1 January 2026 to 31 December 2026. The accredited schemes must abide by their signed Code of Conduct as submitted with their accreditation application.

c) All accredited Schemes must market their products based on the products or benefit structure, as approved by the Registrar, Council for Medical Schemes. No accredited scheme may market unapproved products or benefits.

d) The accredited medical scheme shall not increase its contributions or fees, after the initial increase in 2026, without first consulting the Executive Committee of the SALGBC.
